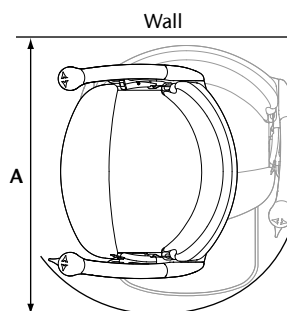
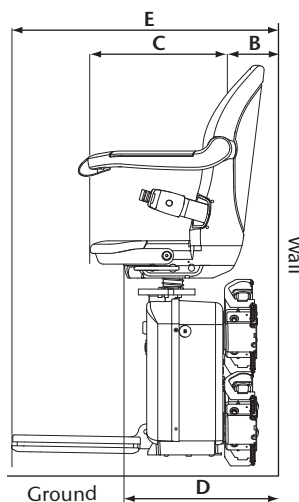
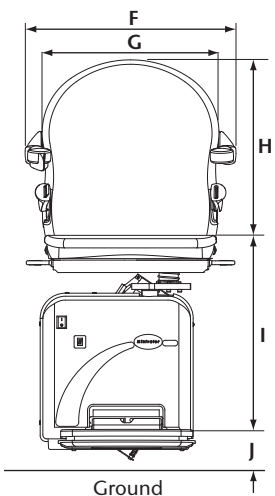

The Minivator 2000 stairlift suits most staircases with bends or corners and offers you all the basic functions that you would expect plus the option to upgrade to a powered seat swivel and/or folding footplate.

With a choice of six upholstery colours and two track colours the Minivator 2000 compliments most colour schemes.



Fitted to the stairs, not the wall, it is unlikely you will need to redecorate following the installation of your Minivator 2000 stairlift.

Like all Minivator stairlifts the Minivator 2000 has a battery backup which means it will continue to work in the event of a power cut so you do not need to worry about being stranded upstairs or down.

The compact unit is designed to fold up leaving the staircase free for other users. The bespoke track is designed to fit your individual staircase and maximise clear space on the stairway. It can be supplied with a powered hinged track if required.

The Minivator 2000 also comes with two remote controls which means, once folded, you can easily send it to the upstairs charge point freeing up space in your hallway.

Safety As Standard

Your Minivator 2000 stairlift will come with a range of safety sensors that are designed to stop your stairlift if it meets any obstruction as you travel up the stairs.



Your Minivator 2000 stairlift has an easy release retractable seat belt for added peace of mind.

If you prefer you can have an easy fasten Velcro seat belt.

The operating toggle is easy to use, simply hold it towards the direction you wish to travel, up or down, and your Minivator 2000 will move smoothly and gently on its way.

The control is conveniently located at the end of the arm leaving both arms clear to provide unhindered support when getting on or off the seat.
